

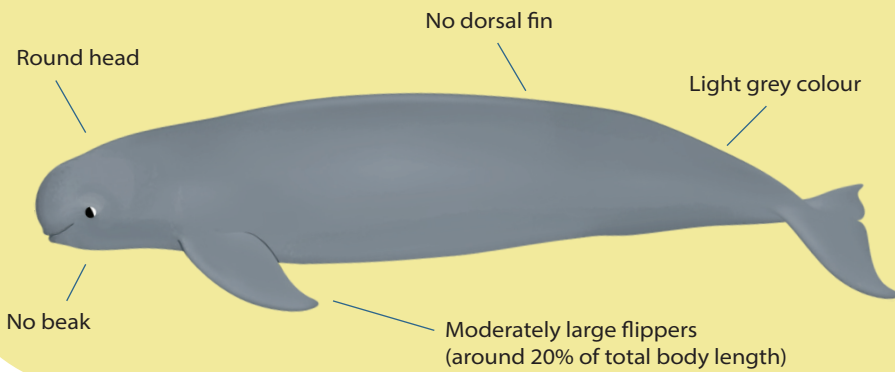
# MARINE MAMMALS OF THE GULF OF MOTTAMA

Working together with the fishing communities in the ZeeKone village, Myanmar Coastal Conservation Lab researchers have been conducting surveys in the Gulf of Mottama since 2018 to collect evidence of the presence of marine mammal species in the region.

The following three species of marine mammals have been observed since.

## INDO-PACIFIC FINLESS PORPOISE

NEOPHOCAENA PHOCAENOIDES

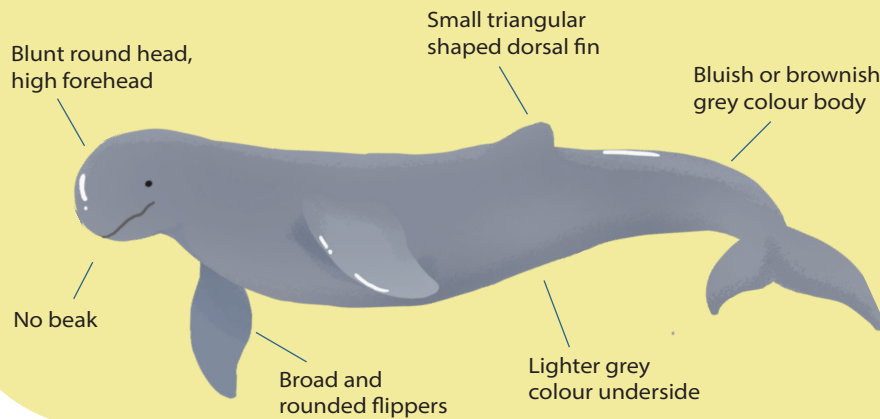


- Can grow up to 2.3m or 7 feet 5 inches
- Weight up to 72kg (159 lbs)
- Estimated lifespan is 33 years



## IRRAWADDY DOLPHIN

ORCAELLA BREVIROSTRIS

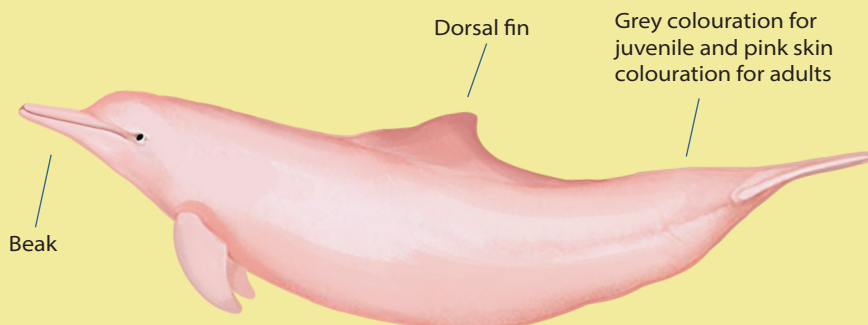


- Can grow up to 2.8 m or 7.5 feet
- Adult weight up to 130 kg (287 lbs)
- Estimated lifespan is 30 years



## INDO-PACIFIC HUMPBAC DOLPHIN

SOUSA CHINENSIS



- Can grow up to between 2 to 3.5 m or 6 feet 7 inches to 11 feet 6 inches
- Adult weight ranges between 50 to 230 kg or 330 to 510 lb
- Estimated lifespan is 33 years
